Matters Arising

Issue	Update
1.Highways Update	Patching has been completed in various areas including the Maesgwynne bend and Bumpwr Road to Blaensan Goch. Groesforth Crossroads: extra signage is expected imminently. DP has a meeting with John Pearce re. drains in Llanglydwen and Rhydownen. The new road boundary at The Bont in Llanglydwen is an ongoing concern. Fferm Fach has been contacted by Carmarthenshire County Council regarding their new entrance. Some improvements have been made. Groesforth to Whitland, DP has a meeting about the road edges next week. DP distributed copies of local road maps to all councillors present. Potholes near Nant-y-Eglwys have been filled in.
2. Cardi Bach Public right of way claim.	Meeting on 3 rd June with Pembrokeshire, Carmarthenshire and Sustrans to discuss organising a meeting with all involved parties.
3. Community Council website	Log-in details now received from W3 Web designs. As there is now a new legal requirement for 'meeting notes', PS will put these onto the website within 7 days as per the legislation (see June agenda note).
4. Super-Fast Broadband	Dyfed IT are expecting to be connected in this area by the end of 2021.
5. Installation of defibrillator into phone box	NT & Jeff have looked at the phone box and think that the amount of electricity required is small so could be powered by a solar panel. They are looking at various options. JT noted that Jeff does monthly checks of the defibrillator.

6. Dog fouling	The dog fouling situation has improved around the leisure path. There are currently no plans for mole traps. PS will look at creating some dog fouling signs and email them to councillors for approval at the next meeting.
7. Market Hall / Leisure path	No update on the fencing. A New Dawn for Llanboidy have a meeting on Friday to look at the logos / names that were suggested by the school children. Railings & gates: DP has two quotes and is waiting for a third. PS to research what is required on the signage for the leisure path, SE will discuss it with A New Dawn for Llanboidy at the Friday meeting and councillors will think about what they would like it to say. It was unanimously agreed that any signage will be bilingual.
8. Pavement in Llanboidy	Rosie Carmichael (Biodiversity Officer, CCC) has said that moving the hedge can be done any time after September. The flashing speed sign is now in situ on this section of road.
9. Grants	Unanimous agreement that grants will be discussed and agreed at the next meeting in July.
10. One Planet Development	Ongoing. No current updates.
11. Toilet redecoration	NT said this should be done this month (June).
12. Carpark cleaning	SE swept up carpark glass this month. Agreed that GP will spray the weeds, etc. in the next few days and then there will be a working party to clear the carpark from 6pm onwards on Wednesday 16 th June.
