**Matters Arising**

Issue	Update
<b>1. Highways Update</b>	DP had a meeting with John Pearce. The rock face near Ben Griffiths yard is going to be revisited after hedge cutting, it is likely to be landowners responsibility. DP has a further list of potholes to report for repair. The dip in the road by “Beechwood” is back again and has been reported. Gwaith Menyn, Llanglydwen: further to flooding last year, a ditch has been dug in the field, old drains are to be blocked and a new gully will be put in place. Fallen tree between Cefn-y-Pant and Llanboidy: landowners responsibility. Fferm Fach; the Council are due to visit again and suggest further improvements, they have written to the landowner.
<b>2. Cardi Bach Public right of way claim.</b>	A very positive meeting was held on 7 <sup>th</sup> July 2021, all parties are keen to keep the project going. All landowners between Llanglydwen and Rhydowen are happy to help the Cardi Bach public right of way open up. DP & Jason Lawday had a meeting two weeks ago and tracked the old railway line to Rhydowen.
<b>3. Super-fast broadband</b>	The money has now been released to the Welsh Government which is a positive step forward.

<b>4. Installation of defibrillator into phone box</b>	Ongoing.
<b>5. Dog fouling</b>	<p>Eco Green Communities dog stations for communal areas. Email forwarded to councillors prior to meeting. SE proposed that we order one for Llanboidy Leisure Path, Delyth Dent seconded the notion.</p> <p>PS to phone and get a draft image done for approval by councillors. This will be done via email so that it can be ordered as soon as possible. It is hoped this will be a constructive, community friendly approach to improving the leisure path for everybody.</p>
<b>6. Market Hall / Leisure path</b>	<p>The fencing has been completed.</p> <p>The Calor grant needs to be spent and is going to be used for picnic tables and outdoor fitness equipment.</p> <p>There was discussion about the potential of the Community Council joining forces with A New Dawn for Llanboidy (ANDL) in order to apply for a National Lottery Community fund grant.</p> <p>ANDL intend to continue on the work with both the market hall and the leisure path.</p> <p>Motion: The Community Council will write to ANDL and ask them to pass over the funds raised through Calor Gas and Crowdfunding. Proposed by DP, seconded by SE.</p> <p>Motion: The Community Council should cover the cost of fencing around the leisure path area. Proposed by RW, seconded by DD.</p> <p>Once funds have been transferred, PS &amp; SE will collaborate on ordering equipment and making payments.</p>
<b>7. Pavement in Llanboidy</b>	See PL/02133. Great news on the planning application being submitted – this is a positive step forward.
<b>8. Grants</b>	<p>All grant applications received up until 31<sup>st</sup> May were considered. As there are sufficient funds from S.137 this year, all grant applications were approved.</p> <p>Grants were awarded to: Urdd (DP/SE), Cruse Bereavement (RW/DD), Llanboidy Market Hall (RD/OY), Cylch Meithrin (RW/OY), Eglwys St. Brynach (DD/RD), Capel Cefn Y Pant (DP/GP), Pwyllgor Cymuned Llanglydwen (SE/DD), Llanboidy Tug of War (SE/RD), Llanboidy Sports &amp; Social Club (OY/RD), Cardi Bach (DP/DD), Tenovous Cancer Care (OY/DD), Air Ambulance (DD/DP), Capel Llanboidy (RD/SE).</p> <p>A total of £8,600 was given out for grants.</p> <p>PS will send all the grant cheques out with a covering letter. It was agreed that everyone who applied for grants this year will be contacted prior to the 2022 deadline to remind them that grants are available.</p>
<b>9. One Planet Development</b>	Ongoing. No current updates.

<b>10. Toilet redecoration</b>	It was unanimously agreed that a fantastic job has been done on the toilets and councillors asked PS to write a letter of thanks. Approved by SE/RW
<b>11. Correspondence</b>	DP asked that PS forward any emails regarding playground equipment.
