Issue	Update
1.Highways Update	An additional drain has been installed by Gwaith Menyn in Llanglydwen and between Llanglydwen and Rhydowen there are two new cross drains. The sweeper has been through Cwm ty Coed. The water has been stopped at the Cilhenros entrance.
2. Planning	PL/03331 Proposed conversion of redundant farm building to holiday let - West Regwm, Llanboidy, Whitland, SA34 OEB PL/03336 Proposed 3 Bedroom Dwelling - Land opposite Maes y Werin, Llanboidy, Whitland, SA34 OEL No comments on either planning application.
3. Cardi Bach Public right of way claim.	Sustrans sent a list to DP, some parts of the old line are not registered to owners so they have asked DP to help identify who these areas belong to.
4. Super-fast broadband	A meeting was held last week, Fonus are looking strong and hoping to start connections in May.
