Matters Arising

Issue	Update
1.Highways Update	Clungwynne ditches to be cleared. A raised hump is being put in at Glyn Perffaith to stop water entering the property. Blaenweneirch, Cwmfelin Boeth, has a bad road surface and has been put on the list for resurfacing. Ffoswine yard, the highway that runs through the yard is in a bad state. There was a lot of storm damage including fallen trees all around the area, lots of clearing has been done. The response from the Council was very good. Request to look at the option of putting a hump in at the entrance of Zoa Chapel on the Whitland road to stop the water coming into the property. DP to enquire.

Planning	PL/03182 First Floor front extension and single storey rear extension to existing house: Pistyll Llefrith, Llanboidy, Whitland, SA34 0LL PL/03599 Certificate of Lawful Development for the retention of a residential caravan and associated garden & parking area (10 years) – The Caravan, Springwell, Llanboidy, Whitland, SA34 0EB No objections to either planning application.
3. Cardi Bach Public right of way claim.	DP has visited some more landowners. There is a meeting this week re. locating more landowners.
4. Super-fast broadband	Carmarthen West & Llanboidy are furthest ahead with progress as high interest was registered. Groundwork due to start in April.

5. Installation of defibrillator into phone box	No update. NT not present.
6. Dog fouling	Dog station has been installed and looks great, thank you DP. DP & RW to look at possible new locations for the dog poo bin provided by the council. If it is put nearer the road, the thinking is that more people would use it.
7. Market Hall / Leisure path	Waiting on quotes for play equipment. No update on the Hall planning.
8. Pavement in Llanboidy	No update.
9. Sunny Hill	PS responded to Jason Lawday to say that we would be happy to have the two stiles and organise volunteers to install them. No response as of yet, PS to follow up.
10. Toilet door closers	No update. NT not present.
11. Zurich: insurance update	Renewal is due 31/05/2022. PS to get quote from Zurich and Cleddau. Do we need a 5-yearly check on trees? What are our obligations? Asset list made in meeting (railings, outdoor equipment, toilets, benches, streetlights, laptop, projector, village name plinths, Christmas lights)
