3. Cardi Bach Public right of way claim.	No current update.
4. Super-fast broadband	DP had a meeting with Vonus in Carmarthen. It is looking good in rural areas and they are hoping to start work within the next two months.
5. Installation of defibrillator into phone box	NT has been working on the phone box over the last day and will have the installation of the defibrillator completed by the next meeting. PS to ask Calon Cymru if they provide stickers (email sent).
