Llanboidy Pavement

Highways

Concerns raised about the sinking of the southbound carriageway at the bottom of Rhydyceised some 100m before the bridge. This ongoing problem has been reported to Highways but will be reported again by email.

Dorian to express concerns to Highways about the speed of traffic passing through Cefn Brafle, and to suggest a speed limit be enforced there for the safety of the cross roads junction and residents.
