1.Highways Update	<p>Proposal for Footpath Pentre Isaf to Pentre Uchaf – Councillor Dorian Phillips is due to have a meeting with the Leader of the Council and the Chief Executive with regards to the Community Council moving forward with the footpath. Meeting has not yet taken place due to current restrictions.</p> <p>Richard Waters – Councillor Dorian Phillips has requested an update on the following issues:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The speed flashing sign entering from St Clears 2. Groesffordd 3. Maesgwynne Bends <p>Again, due to current restriction, no update received. Work will be carried out in due course but timescale not known</p> <p>Llanglydwen – Councillor Dorian Phillips met with John Pearce at Llanglydwen on 5thMarch due to flooding and blocked drains. Council are looking to improve drainage by diverting some of the existing drains. Landowners consent will be needed</p> <p>No updates on the above due to current situation with COVID-19 lockdown. DP informed the council that small jobs such as the repair of potholes etc were still being Carried out where necessary.</p>
2. Market Hall / Play Park.	<p>Grant applied for through Calor Community Fund for equipment has been successful into round 2 of the application process. Still a lot of work to be done, and Community Support will be vital. A press release will be upcoming asking the community for Likes and Pledges on a Community Hubble / Crowdfunding page. Likes and Pledges will give points to enable the application through to the next stage.</p>
