| 1. Highways Update                       | DP: Wants to look at whether the footpath issue can be resolved with out planning. <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Lots of potholes fixed in the area.</li><li>- DP has chased (name) regarding the hedges.</li></ul>   |
