D Phillips had the reported the following issues; Potholes - Road between Whitland Abbey and Llanboidy (C3223), road between Kennels and Login (C3423) and from Maesgwyn to Crosshands (C3205). The following roads have also been reported as needing work; Llanboidy to Glasfryn (U3282), between Werberni and Brynawel (C3216), near Treblaedded (U3281), Blaensarngoch to Clyngwyn junction (C3203) and Llaindelin to Sunny Hill (U6214).</p> <p>Cllr Phillips reported that the County Council has some additional funds for road maintenance and was hopeful that some of the outstanding works may be completed.</p> <p>The Clerk presented the costings for horse warning signs to the Council. Cllr D Phillips proposed, and O Young seconded that 10 aluminium composite signs be purchase at a cost of £126.45; all Councillors agreed.</p>	Clerk to order signs.
2. Access around Market Hall, Llanboidy / Play Park.	<p>No developments.</p> <p>The Council was briefed by Cllr D Phillips regarding a meeting held in the hall regarding the hall/park grant application. A representative who assists with grants from the County Council was in attendance and advised that a partnership should be formed between the hall and the Community Council to make the application. J Phillips proposed, R Davies seconded, and all councillors agreed that a partnership be formed.</p>
