PL/01675	Dyffryn Brodyn Limited is seeking planning permission to install external transformers at Dyffryn Brodyn Wind Farm due to the failing of the existing internal transformers. The proposed works include the installation of new external transformers on a concrete plinth adjacent to each of the 11 turbines. Underground cables would connect the transformers to the generators within the turbine - Wind Farm, Dyffryn Brodyn, Blaenwaun, Whitland, SA34 0JE
